



## HOW TO CREATE A WORLD CLIMATE SCHOOL CHAPTER IN YOUR AREA

There are many ways to start a World Climate School chapter in your area, but this is what I consider essential:

- Gathering a group of potential teachers / communicators who are highly motivated to work with this. Let them constitute the core of the World Climate School chapter.
- Equipping them with all the knowledge they need about climate change by taking them through the complete "World Climate School".
- Supplying them with a set of slideshows for their own use / to be edited and changed by them to fit their personal preferences.
- Supervising them in developing their own teaching style, creating their own slideshows.
- Helping local schools develop their own climate education programs, thus integrating climate change in their curriculum.
- Creating a plan for the avalanche to happen: Implement the teach the teachers system in your school systems, in relevant organisations, in your local area, or in your country as a whole.
- If possible, anchor this effort solidly by integrating it in a resourceful and well functioning organisation. If not possible, start anyway without it.

My role - and the role of our local World Climate School team - can be:

- Delivering basic teaching material.
- Educate the first group of teachers - preferably via internet, that will cost you nothing - or, if you can find funding for travel, board and lodging for me / my team - this can happen as a live person to person course in a place of your choice.
- Coaching your World Climate School chapter via internet / Skype or similar communication channels.
- And we are open to other options also if needed.

My hope is, that we through 2020 will have capacity to develop a video based version of World Climate School, accessible by everyone, everywhere on the planet. But at this time that remains to be created. In the meantime, I can refer you to other video based climate



education programs, covering parts of the content of World Climate School. These programs are web based.

Please start the process as soon as possible. I am 74 years old, and do not expect to live forever, so if you want me to help you, we should get this started soon. And the planet is very impatient!
